## Writing

As with all of Jeanie Baker's work, The Hidden Forest includes beautiful WORD CHOICE and strong imagery. Like the kelp in the story, the SENTENCE FLUENCY gently ebbs and flows along with the story. This book certainly lends itself to vocabulary instruction with loads of rich tier 2 words.

## Reading

I would encourage you to discuss the way Baker has created such a vivid picture in the reader's mind. What words did she use? How did she describe the different parts underneath the water? Because of the descriptive writing this text would be useful for discussing VISUALISING. I suspect many QUESTIONS would come out of the storyline and the theme of the book. You could also use this text to get students to have a go at SUMMARISING the story using the most important details only. (What is the story mainly about?)

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
