She tries all different types of things to make it go away but it takes the help of others to get her to the top of the slope. This would be a great discussion starter for a social-emotional learning lesson.

As far as writing goes, the ORGANISATION is clear in this text, with lots of sequencing words guiding the reader through. IDEAS- this book could lead to writing about how students feel about different things (or attempting to display their feelings as metaphors as the author has done here). SENTENCE FLUENCY abounds in this book

This book lends itself really well to discussions around INFERRING and QUESTIONING. What might the slope mean?
